To My Friends and Neighbors,

In 1964, one of my greatest heroes, Ronald Reagan, addressed a nation on the verge of an election. He said that moment was “a time for choosing.” Calling out the dangers of socialism, he said we had a rendezvous with destiny to preserve for our children the hope of America, or else see liberalism extinguish liberty’s flame.

I admire many things about President Reagan. He could deliver one-liners, political zingers, and inspire with his words. But he also knew how to roll up his sleeves and make things happen. That’s the model of leadership I’ve followed during my 9 years representing this part of Texas in the state legislature, and that’s why we’ve accomplished more conservative victories than at any other time in Texas history:

- Nearly \$3 billion for border security, including more manpower and technology to stop illegal crossings
- The nation’s strongest pro-life laws, including a total ban on abortion once a baby’s heartbeat is detected
- Tough new election integrity reforms that protect our elections from fraud
- New funding for law enforcement that stopped the “defund the police” movement in its tracks
- Overhauling school finance to dedicate resources to classroom education, teacher pay, and giving rural schools their fair share
- Protecting the power grid by reforming energy regulations to ensure we will never go dark in times of need
